Subject Matter/Background

Resolution 36-2021 authorizes the purchase of street lights relating to the Cleveland Road Street Lighting Project. This resolution relates to Resolution 37-2021 awarding the bid for the construction portion of the project. While the stated lead time is 5-7 weeks, longer lead times are expected due to COVID-19. The fixtures selected are identical to the harbor-style lights installed at the entrance to the boat ramp, and will be installed on the existing bases constructed as part of the US-6 Phase I Paving Project.

Three bids were obtained for the purchase of these fixtures, with the Power Line Supply bid being the lowest and best bid (copies of bids are attached as Exhibit 1:

- Pepco \$152,010.00;
- WESCO Distribution, Inc. \$156,166.00; and
- Power Line Supply \$151,633.55.

Financial Review

The street lighting project along US-6 is included in the City's Capital Improvement Plan and discussed annually during the budget process. \$200,000 of the project, which included setting the bases and conduit were included with the US-6, Phase 1 project. The purchase of the lights, in the amount of \$151,633.55, will be paid for out of the Street Lighting Fund and Community Infrastructure Fund, which has sufficient funds for this purchase.

Legal Review

The matter has been reviewed, follows normal administrative procedure, and is properly before you.

Recommendation

If Council is in agreement, a motion adopting Resolution 36-2021 is in order.

Subject Matter/Background

This Resolution authorizes the work to complete the installation of street lights on US 6 in the areas between Berlin Road and Williams St. The effort to modernize the City's street lighting, which began in earnest with the Main St. streetscape, is aimed towards improving safety and aesthetics along major thoroughfares. The existing street lights along US 6 are owned by Ohio Edison and the city is responsible for the electricity consumed by each light. The upgrade to the new lighting style provides a few advantages: (1) while the city still pays the electricity, conversion from sodium based to LED greatly reduces the amount of energy consumed, (2) the lighting technology allows for greater light dispersion with fewer lights, reducing the total number of poles/lights, (3) the harbor-style poles with white LED light greatly improves the aesthetic and night-time safety compared to the timber based poles with orange light.

Financial Review

The street lighting project along US-6 is included in the City's Capital Improvement Plan and discussed annually during the budget process. \$200,000 of the project, which included setting the bases and conduit were included with the US-6, Phase 1 project. The work performed to install the lights and run the wire, in the amount of \$326,100, will be paid for out of various funding sources, including the Street Lighting Fund and Community Infrastructure Fund. The City is expected to also issue a short-term note to pay for the remaining balance of the project, which is estimated to be approximately \$200,000, after utilizing available funds. The note will be rolled into the anticipated G.O. Bond that will be issued with the US- 6, Phase 2 project. The source of revenue used to pay down the lighting project debt will derive from the electric kilowatt hour excise tax.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD THE BID AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH NATIONAL LIGHT & POWER FOR LABOR AND MATERIALS RELATED TO THE CLEVELAND ROAD LIGHTING PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED TWENTY-SIX THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$326,100.00)

Therefore, the City Manager shall be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to award the bid and enter into an agreement with the said National Light & Power for undertaking the work called for in the Cleveland Road Lighting Project bid package, in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand One Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$326,100.00), which agreement shall be substantially in the form of the Cleveland Road Lighting Contract on file in the office of the Clerk of Council.

That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including O.R.C. §121.22.

Subject Matter/Background

In the fall of 2020, Council passed legislation for an annual sidewalk repair program. The administration implemented the sidewalk inspection and repair program in 2020 and will continue the program on an annual basis. The engineering and zoning departments identified necessary repairs on Cleveland Road. Property owners were notified and given the choice of making the repair themselves or having the City complete the work. In late 2020, 5 parcels were identified for sidewalk repairs and the City contracted with Smith Paving for the work. Out of the 5 parcels, 2 owners reimbursed the City for the repairs. The remaining owners chose to have the amount added to the property tax duplicate as an assessment. The total cost of the project, which was fronted by the City's capital fund, costed a total of \$13,896 across all 5 parcels.

Financial Review

This legislation authorizes the Finance Director to certify the amounts to be assessed on the tax duplicate for the remaining three parcels. Approximately \$10,600 will be collected by the City over a 5 to 10 year period to recover the cost of the sidewalk repair and interest in accordance with the established codified ordinance. Assessment collections will be deposited in the Property Maintenance Fund and used to reimburse the City as well as seed funding for future property maintenance repairs. More details on the assessed amounts are available in the Finance Department, upon request.

Legal Review

The matter has been reviewed, follows normal administrative procedure and is properly before you.

Recommendation

If Council is in agreement, a motion adopting Resolution No. 38-2021 is in order.

A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING UNPAID SIDEWALK REPAIR AND/OR CONSTRUCTION CHARGES TO THE ERIE COUNTY AUDITOR FOR COLLECTION.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Huron, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That, pursuant to Section 521.06 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Huron, it is hereby determined and declared that the list of sidewalk repair and/or construction charges on file in the office of the Finance Director of the City, which list is hereby incorporated herein by reference, is delinquent and unpaid. The Finance Director is hereby directed to do all things necessary to cause said unpaid sidewalk repair and/or construction charges to be certified to the Eric County Auditor for collection as other taxes, and the Erie County Auditor is hereby requested pursuant to statute, to cause said charges to be extended on the First Half 2022 tax duplicate for collection in installments as certified by the Finance Director in accordance with Section 521 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Huron.

SECTION 2. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including O.R.C. §121.22.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately following its adoption.
