A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD THE BID AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH UNDERGROUND UTILITIES, INC. FOR LABOR AND MATERIALS RELATED TO THE BERLIN ROAD WATERMAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE AND 97/100 DOLLARS (\$1,159,661.97)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HURON, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the City having advertised for bids in connection with the Berlin Road Watermain Replacement Project, this Council finds Underground Utilities, Inc. to be the lowest and best bidder for such work. Therefore, the City Manager shall be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to award the bid and enter into an agreement with the said Underground Utilities, Inc. for undertaking the work called for in the Berlin Road Watermain Replacement Project bid package, in an amount not to exceed One Million One Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-One and 97/100 Dollars (\$1,159,661.97), which agreement shall be substantially in the form of the Berlin Road Watermain Replacement Contract on file in the office of the Clerk of Council.

SECTION 2. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including O.R.C. §121.22.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its adoption.
