A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, ON BEHALF OF THE PLANNING AND ENGINEERING DEPARTMENTS, TO FILE A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION- SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM FOR POTENTIAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TOWARD THE BERLIN ROAD PEDESTRIAN PATH PROJECT.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HURON AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Huron authorizes and directs the City Manager, on behalf of the Engineering and Planning Departments, to file a grant application through Safe Routes to School Grant Program to become eligible for potential funding assistance toward the Berlin Road Pedestrian Path Project.
