A RESOLUTION RATIFYING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO U.S. CONGRESSWOMAN MARCY KAPTUR'S FY26 HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT COMMUNITY FUNDING REQUEST RELATING TO THE HURON MUNICIPAL BOAT BASIN RENOVATION PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIVE MILLION AND XX/100 DOLLARS (\$5,000,000.00); AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT SAID GRANT AWARD(S) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIVE MILLION AND XX/100 DOLLARS (\$5,000,000.00), SHOULD THE APPLICATION BE SUCCESSFUL.

WHEREAS, the City of Huron has made a grant application to U.S. Congresswoman Marcy Kaptur's FY26 Housing and Urban Development Community Funding Request relating to the Huron Municipal Boat Basin Renovation Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City meets basic eligibility requirements for funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Huron has the authority to apply for financial assistance and to administer the amounts received from U.S. Congresswoman Marcy Kaptur's FY26 Housing and Urban Development Funding Request; and

WHEREAS, the City of Huron must direct and authorize the City Manager to act as the Authorized Representative for the application and Project, if awarded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HURON AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Huron hereby ratifies submission of a grant application to Congresswoman Marcy Kaptur's FY26 Housing and Urban Development Community Funding Request to become eligible for potential funding assistance relating to the Huron Municipal Boat Basin Renovation Project in an amount not to exceed Five Million and xx/100 Dollars (\$5,000,000.00).

SECTION 2. If grant funds are awarded, the City Manager is further authorized and directed to execute an agreement for and on behalf of the City of Huron, Ohio with U.S. Congresswoman Marcy Kaptur's FY26 Housing and Urban Development Community Funding Request in an amount not to exceed Five Million and xx/100 Dollars (\$5,000,000.00).

SECTION 3. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including O.R.C. §121.22.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall go into effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
