

Huron Safety Town Teen Counselor Application

For those who have never volunteered for Safety Town before... What is Safety Town?

Safety Town is a program that allows children entering kindergarten to learn safe ways to approach school and everyday situations. The children are taught the basics of fire, water, traffic, playground safety, as well as poison control, bus behavior and seatbelt importance. These concepts are taught through songs, projects, movies, and games. On average there are 80-plus children attending Safety Town each year.

What is a Safety Town Counselor?

Safety Town Counselors are one of the most important parts in running a successful program. The typical age of a Safety Town counselor is between 7th and 9th grade. We do have some older, experienced Safety Town counselors who are in 10th, 11th and 12th grade. **Safety Town Counselors must have completed 6th grade before Safety Town begins.**

These counselors are vital in the day-to-day operations of Safety Town. Each counselor could be assigned to assist in a classroom, help on the blacktop outside, be an office assistant, or help with snacks. Please note that you could be assigned to any one of these areas and each assignment is important to Safety Town! These counselors help the teacher and help the kids, because we all know, when we were 5 or 6, we couldn't do everything ourselves!

More importantly, a Safety Town Counselor is responsible for bringing excitement and energy to the participants. Many children in Safety Town are nervous on the first day and it is the role of the counselor to make sure they feel comfortable. Counselors make sure the kids are safe and have fun!

Note: Counselor service is limited to three years for an individual.

When is Safety Town?

2025 Safety Town will take place from June 16 - 18th and 23 - 25th – from 9 am to noon, at Woodlands School. Counselors are expected to arrive 15 minutes early each day. Counselors must also attend a meeting on Friday, June 13th which includes helping with set-up.

Community Service Hours for HHS students

Safety Town is a great way to help your community and gain Community Service Hours. You must bring the required paperwork from your guidance counselor to the counselor's meeting prior to the start of Safety Town. Forms will be completed after completion of the Safety Town program, and you will be responsible for picking up these forms at our office (110 Wall Street).
